

C3/3 online Activity

Workshops : Storytelling keep on going, school mediation and EU citizenship”

Hosting School: 4GELA/GR

Time: 10:00 CEST

The online activity will take place on Cisco Webex platform and will last approximately 3 hours. The link above should be shared among the students involved and the Erasmus partner-teachers on demand.

GUIDELINES

10:00 (CEST time): All participants enter the main room.

- The Erasmus Coordinator greets the participants.
- Mrs Boukorou explains how the workshops will be carried out.

10:15 : The students enter the breakout rooms and work for 1,45 hour.

Each student, whose number has been assigned by their own school, enters the corresponding room + one teacher from each partner school (for example, Room 1/breaking out session 1: all the number 1; Room 2/breaking session: all the number 2, etc.)

Once in the groups, after the students introduce themselves (name and school), the student from Greece nominated as Coordinator will propose a starting point for the storytelling activity and will sketch the composition frame of the story.

In each group there will be a student Writer/Secretary who will keep notes of the essential parts of the story, and then this student will also be the Presenter of a short report of the story when back into the main Room.

The teachers would supervise the timing and support the students if necessary.

The story will include a conflict between parties, one or two mediators, mediation and resolution of the conflict.

12:00 h: All students and teachers will come back into the Main Session.

The Presenters of each group will briefly report the story created by their own group (10 minutes maximum per report).

13:00 h: Farewell and conclusion of the activities.

WHAT EACH PARTNER SCHOOL SHOULD DO BEFORE THE ACTIVITY

Each partner school chooses 6-8 students and 2 or more teachers who will participate to the meeting. Every student will be assigned a number (from 1 to 6). When during the Meeting the breaking out sessions' activities start, all the number 1 will enter Room 1, all the number 2 Room 2, and so on until Room 6.

By tomorrow morning 1/6/21, each partner school will send to Mrs Panopoulou the list of the students with the assigned number + the list of the teachers.

In order to develop cooperation within the working groups during the storytelling, it would be advisable to explain in advance that in each group there will be a student from 4GELA who will act as a Coordinator, will introduce the starting point/issue of the story as well as coordinate the group activity, while another group member will take notes and report briefly the story once back in the main session.

We hope that all students will cooperate and be active.

At the end of the breaking out sessions' activities, students and teachers will come back in the main session room and one student from each group will report the story briefly (max. 10 minutes per student).

For activity's audio-video feedback Mrs Boukorou will be in charge.
