CLIL - teaching subjects such as science, history and geography to students through a foreign language.

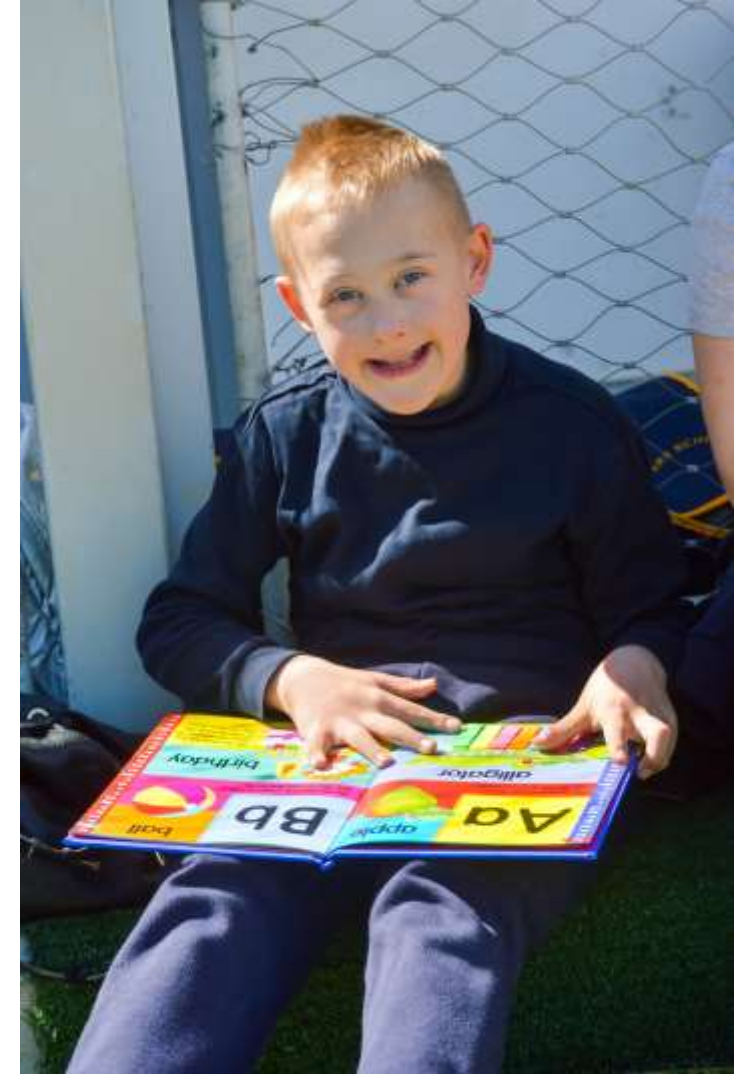

Year 1 (age 5) to Year 6 (age 10):

- English

Subjects taught at Newark

Year 7 (age 11) to Year 8 (age 12):

- Same as Year 1-6
- Introduction of French
- Introduction of Italian



Subjects taught at Newark

Year 9 (age 13) to Year 11 (age 15):

- Same as Year 7-8
- Introduction of Physics (replacing Science)
- Students choose to focus on either French or Italian
- Students choose an option of 2 additional subjects;
 - Option A: Biology + Chemistry
 - Option B: Accounts + Economics





Newark's Afterschool Activities

Our school finishes at 1:30pm, therefore we have various afterschool activities which students can participate in.

Some of the activities include Arts & Crafts, Maths Club, Sports Club, Homework Club and many others!

Newark School welcomes all ideas and suggestions of students and parents, so that we introduce new activities which our children wish to participate in.

Newark Summer School

Each week we will have a different theme such as The Jungle, Aquatic Animals, Music, Planets etc. Our group of amazing educators work on these themes and prepare lots of fun activities for the students.

Students follow a timetable including English and Maths lessons together with Arts & Crafts, Science Experiments, and other interactive and educational activities.



Intensive English Programme

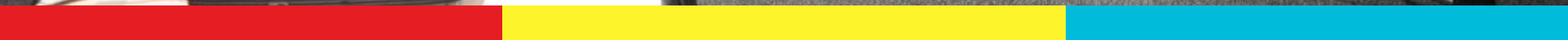
Newark also offers an Intensive English Programme which is dedicated to students with a low level of English. This course runs from August to September, just before the start of the scholastic year.
